Why use the Passive?

- To emphasize the object or party receiving the action
 - Rebecca was selected for a free gift.
- To emphasize the action instead of the actor
 - Our car was repaired by our neighbor.
- When the agent (doer) is unknown or not important
 - Her house was broken into last night.

After the session held last night, the government announced that it would raise all salaries in public sector

New budget scheme that will be introduced will result in lower salaries for all workers.

1st sentence – PRAISE THE GOVERNMENT! IT BRINGS US NOTHING BUT JOY AND HIGH SALARIES. 2nd SENTENCE – LET'S HIDE THE DOER – WHY BLAME THE GOVERNMENT, NO ONE TAKES RESPONSIBILITY

Passive Voice Structure

• There are two main rules to all Passive Voice forms:

1. Add the verb "Be" in the same tense as the sentence in its active voice form

2. Use the Past Participle form of the main verb

Structure

She plays tennis.

- SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE so use the Simple Present tense of verb TO BE (am, is, are)
- We must use PAST PARTICIPLE

V + ED III COLUMN

TENNIS AM, IS, ARE PLAYED.

TENNIS IS PLAYED.

Passive Voice Structure

- **O LEARNING PASSIVE IN FIVE STEPS:**
- STEP ONE: Find OBJECT of the sentence.

They are watching TV.

She bought a book.

They had called her.

Structure

- LEARNING PASSIVE IN FIVE STEPS:
- STEP TWO: PUT THE MAIN VERB IN PAST PARTICIPLE FORM.

They are watching TV.

watch - watched

She bought a book.

buy - bought

They had called her.

call - called

Structure

- **LEARNING PASSIVE IN FIVE STEPS:**
- STEP THREE: USE VERB TO BE! THE FORM OF VERB TO BE DEPENDS ON THE TENSE OF THE ACTIVE SENTENCE!

SIMPLE PRESENT - AM, IS, ARE
PRESENT CONTINUOUS - AM, IS, ARE + BEING
SIMPLE PAST - WAS, WERE
PAST CONTINUOUS - WAS, WERE + BEING
PAST PERFECT - HAD BEEN
MODAL VERBS - WILL, CAN, SHOULD, MUST - BE

Structure

In Continuous/Progressive tense sentences add the continuous form of "Be" which is "being"

• Ex: More homes are being built this year.

IF THERE IS –ING IN ACTIVE SENTENCE THERE MUST BE BEING IN PASSIVE SENTENCE!

SHE IS WATCHING TV – TV IS BEING WATCHED.
THEY WERE BUILDING A HOUSE – A HOUSE WAS
BEING BUILT.

Structure

- **O LEARNING PASSIVE IN FIVE STEPS:**
- STEP FOUR: CHOOSE PLURAL OR SINGULAR FORM OF THE VERB DEPENDING ON THE SUBJECT OF THE PASSIVE SENTENCE:

They are watching TV.
TV am, is, are being watched.
TV is being watched.
They called her.
She was were called.
She was called.

Structure

- **O LEARNING PASSIVE IN FIVE STEPS:**
- STEP FIVE: ADD BY AT THE END OF THE SENTENCE IF NECESSARY.

They are watching TV.

TV is being watched BY THEM.

He called her.

She was called BY HIM.

Simple Present

ACTIVE

- I walk the dogs everyday.
- Millions of people watch the Super Bowl.

PASSIVE

- The dogs are walked everyday.
- The Super Bowl is watched by millions of people.

Present Continuous

ACTIVE

- I am walking the dogs.
- Millions of people are watching the Super Bowl.

PASSIVE

- The dogs are being walked.
- The Super Bowl is being watched by millions of people.

Simple Past

ACTIVE

I walked the dogs.

 Millions of people watched the Super Bowl.

PASSIVE

The dogs were walked.

 The Super Bowl was watched by millions of people.

Past Continuous

ACTIVE

- I was walking the dogs.
- Millions of people were watching the Super Bowl.

PASSIVE

 The dogs were being walked.

 The Super Bowl was being watched by millions of people.

Past Perfect

ACTIVE

- I had walked the dogs already.
- Millions of people had watched the Super Bowl.

PASSIVE

- The dogs had been walked already.
- The Super Bowl had been watched by millions of people.

Passive Voice MODAL VERBS

ACTIVE

- I must walk the dogs.
- Millions of people could watch the Super Bowl.

PASSIVE

- The dogs must be walked.
- The Super Bowl could be watched by millions of people.

- Vujjek, svaki dan, često, ponekad SIMPLE PRESENT
- Juče, prošle nedjelje/mjeseca, prije 5 godina, 1989 –
 SIMPLE PAST
- Sada, u ovom trenutku, upravo sada PRESENT CONTINUOUS
- Kada sam/smo/ste, dok, u 7 sati juče PAST CONTINUOUS
- Ikada, nikada, tek, već, u poslednje vrijeme, skorije PRESENT PERFECT (kada nije bitno vrijeme, nije spomenuto, samo je rezultat bitan
- Prije nego, prije, kada Već je



The European Union guarantees its citizens that they can live and work anywhere within the EU, provided they can support themselves. Likewise/Also, the European Union devotes a lot of attention to creating (the creation of) harmonized standards in order to contribute to development and maintenance of an efficient, single market. Within the EU, which in some affairs/issues resembles a federation, especially when it comes to/regarding/concerning economic and social affairs/issues, member states make joint efforts/collaborate/collaborate to deliver peace and prosperity through setting up/founding/establishing/forming common institutions. The European Parliament and the Council of the

setting up/founding/establishing/forming common institutions. The European Parliament and the Council of the European Union are the two main bodies of the Union authorized to legislate/adopt/pass laws. The elections for the European Parliament have been held, directly in each member state, every five years since 1979. In exceptional cases, if a state joins the EU between the two elections, additional elections are held for their members. This has

occurred/happened four times, the most recent example being when Romania and Bulgaria joined the EU in 2007.
